



COUNTY AUCTION BARN FAQs

Q: How do I consign items to this auction?

You can bring your items any Friday. We are open Fridays only, 9 AM -12 NOON for drop off.

Q: Are there items you will not accept for this auction?

Yes. Currently, the following items are not accepted: Console Sewing Machines (except treadle); Console and Box TVs; Console Stereos; Paint; Used Tires; Used Building Material; Bowling Balls; Baby Cribs; Car Seats; High Chairs; Used Plastic Children's Toys; Old Mattresses and Box Springs; Upholstered Furniture; Appliances (older than 5 years); Compressed Furniture; Crutches; Stuffed Animals; Ironing Boards; Electric Organs; Upright Planos; Garage Sale Leftovers; Items of No Value.

Q: Do I need to bring someone to help me unload my items?

Yes. However, KIKO associates are available to assist if help is needed with larger items.

Q: Is there a forklift available to load/unload heavy equipment?

Yes, we do have a forklift available to help load/unload heavy equipment.

Q: How should I group my items?

We recommend putting like items together.

Q: I have some antiques. Can I put them on the inside of the building to sell?

Yes. We sell antiques, antique furniture, coins and jewelry on the inside of the building weekly.

Q: I've never been to an auction to buy before. What do I need to register?

You will need an Ohio driver's license or an Ohio state ID card. Out-of-state buyers will need prior approval from auctioneer.

Q: What is the auction format?

Our auction is live and very fast paced. Most sale days, we will be selling two auctions at the same time. So bring a friend!

Q: Can I bid on the items that I consigned, or have someone bid on them on my behalf?

No. Our auction is an Absolute Auction. No bid rigging is tolerated!

Q: When and how do I get paid for the items that I consign?

The settlement and checks are mailed directly to the consignor within 14 days of the auction.

Q: Can I call to find out how much my items sold for?

No. We sell thousands of items each night. If you would like to know how much your items sold for, please attend the auction. Your settlement statement will have sale prices when you get your check.

Q: Am I required to attend the auction if I consign items?

No. You're welcome to attend but it's not required.

Q: What if there is an item I bring that does not sell? What happens to it?

If an item does not get a bid, it may be added to your other items or not sold. Any items left after the auction will be disposed of.

Q: If I purchase a large item, can I pick it up at a later date?

Normally, yes. Please check with the auctioneer regarding picking up an item at a later date.

Q: If I buy items, can I sell items to other buyers at the auction?

No. Solicitation of this sort is strictly prohibited. Collusions with other buyers is prohibited.

Q: I have a vehicle to sell. How do I sell it at the auction?

Bring it any Friday between 9 AM-12 NOON. You must have the title with you when you deliver it. We can notarize the title if needed. Title must be in the seller's name.

Q: I see that sometimes after the auction there are miscellaneous items left in the sale lot. Can I take those items?

No. If you did not purchase the items, you cannot take the items. Thieves will be prosecuted.

Q: When should I put the items I won in my vehicle?

When the auctioneer says "Sold" to you, the item becomes yours. Take it and put it in your vehicle.

Q: When do I pay for my purchases?

All items must be paid for in full at the time of purchase. Do not leave without paying.

Q: I can't attend the auction but want to buy an item. Can I do a phone or absentee bid?

No phone bids are accepted. Occasionally on larger items, the auctioneer may accept an absentee bid.

Q: I have a home full of items to sell. Do you offer a pick-up service?

Yes. For a quote, contact the auctioneer. We do not offer pick up for one or just a few items. Truckloads only.

Q: I have enough items to hold my own auction at the County Auction site. Is this possible?

Yes. Frequently, we conduct auctions throughout the week for Special Consignments.

Q: I have a house to sell. Can you help me explore my options? What is the best way to sell it?

Yes. Contact KIKO and we can assist you in making the best decision on how to sell your real estate.
